Return to In-Church Plan

Phase 1: Back to two services effective October 4th

- Masks will be worn at all times when inside.
- Usher will advise people to sanitize at entry point and provide bulletin and communion serving.
- We will print the words for the hymns in the bulletins.
- Hymns will be limited to one verse opening hymn and one verse sending hymn with special music played as hymn of the day.
- We will continue to use pre-filled communion cups through this phase.
- Offering receptacles will be placed in the entry way for people to put their offering in before or after the service.
- Worshippers will mark their pew the first time they attend and will continue to use that space each week there-after.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in all common areas
- There will be no physical contact shaking hands/communion etc...
- No one will leave their pews until the end of service and children will remain in pews during service (including children's message & offering).
- Children's activity bags will not be available until Phase 3.
- Pastor will dismiss each pew and members will be asked to leave the building as soon as they are able.
- Restrooms will be available but please limit to one person at a time.
- No coffee and fellowship between services.
- Ushers will wipe down entry way and bathroom door handles after service.
- No Sunday School during this phase.
- Confirmation will be held once a month in person but social distanced alternating locations monthly.

Confirmation 2020-2021

Confirmation will be held for students 7th-9th grade. We will meet in person once a month beginning October. 25th at 12:00 – Nora.
