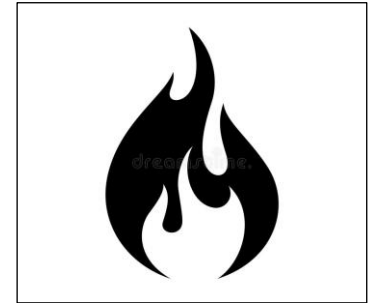
**Confession and Forgiveness**
