

Nora 2022 Great Harvest Challenge

Pledges are to be made before December 31, 2022 to be matched, up to \$10,000, to help us rebuild our budget and funds at Nora Lutheran Church.

It is imperative that we raise these funds in order to keep our church sustained and we look for all those who are members, are friends or join us from afar on line to consider giving a gift – which will be doubled just by your pledging – in these last two months of 2022.
