
Lenten Service March 29, 2023

Paul (1 Timothy 1:15): We marvel at the story of amazing grace in the life of Paul, who turned from persecutor of Christ to proclaimer of our Lord through the mighty power of the Holy Spirit.



The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost. 1 Timothy 1:15

Confession and forgiveness

- L: The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.
- C: He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever.
- L: He does not deal with us according to our sins.
- C: Nor repay us according to our iniquities.
- L: For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him:
- C: As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.
- L: As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him.
- C: For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust.
- L: The Lord remembers that we are dust. He knows our fallen sinfulness and calls us to repent of our sins. Paul, who once persecuted the church, rejoiced in the grace he received, and the mercy shown to him. Let us confess our sins to God and ask that he would show mercy to us.
- C: Almighty, God, with Paul we too are foremost in sin. We sin against you daily. With our words and actions, we hurt others, even those in the body of Christ, our brothers and sisters in faith. We turn from your Word and your ways to follow the path of our own sinful desires. Have mercy on us and forgive us.
- L: The Lord remembers that we are dust; he knows our sinful frame. He has shown grace to his servant Paul and to us through the gift of his Son, our Savior Jesus Christ. Jesus took our sins onto himself and carried them to the cross. Our sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and Son and Holy Spirit.
- C: God does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. As far as the east is from the west, so frar does he remove our transgressions from us.

Prayer of the Day:

Almighty God, even though Paul persecuted your church, arrested the faithful and approved of their deaths, you called him to be an ambassador for your kingdom, sending him into the world to spread the good news of salvation in Jesus. You have looked on us in grace and you have forgiven our sins. Help us to live in repentant humility and ever seek your mercy. By the power of your Spirit, lead us to grow in faith and in knowledge of your Word so that we too can serve as faithful witnesses to our Savior's love. Hear our prayer in Jesus' name. Amen.
